



The KVLC Youth Board Scholarship Program

Step 1

Please nominate to the KVLC Youth Board one senior and one junior (two students total) from your high school that best exemplify the following characteristics:

- Civic mindedness
- Leadership
- Enthusiasm

These students must be willing to commit to attending at least five out of seven KVLC events from September through Election Day, as provided in Step 2. Please submit these students' names and contact information to kidsvoting@gmail.com no later than 5 PM on the Friday immediately following Labor Day. Generally, the September Planning Meeting will take place the following Thursday. KVLC will respond to your e-mail with details regarding time and place of the September Planning Meeting (and other events) within 24 hours of receiving your nominees.

Step 2

The two KVLC Youth Board Members from your school will be expected to attend and/or participate in at least five of the following seven events:

- September Planning Meeting (Youth Board Convenes)
- October Planning Meeting (First of Two)
- October Planning Meeting (Second of Two)
- October Debate
- KVLC Outreach
- KVLC Fundraiser
- Ballot Box Blowout

Step 3

Each public and private high school in Leon County is entitled to nominate two students (one senior and one junior) to the KVLC Youth Board. All qualifying KVLC Youth Board Members (*i.e.* KVLC Youth Board Members attending and/or participating in at least five out of the seven events listed in Step 2) will be entered into a random drawing for KVLC's \$1,000 Scholarship, which is awarded once per two-year cycle. The KVLC Scholarship Recipient will be invited to KVLC's post-election celebratory luncheon. Upon receipt of a copy of the student's high school diploma or other proof of graduation, KVLC will disburse the KVLC Scholarship funds to the KVLC Scholarship Recipient.
